
JOYFUL NOISE

Hirschy Vineyard Pinot Noir 2020



- Harvested September 2020
- Vineyard Sourcing: Hirschy Vineyard, 100% 667
- Yamhill-Carlton AVA, Willamette Valley
- Whole Cluster fermented in small one-ton lot, inoculated with a wild Pied de Cuve, pigeaged daily after the first 4 days of fermentation, pressed to tank at -1 brix, settled for 48hrs, then moved to barrel.
- Aged for 18 months in Neutral French oak.
- Tasting Notes: 2020 was possibly the most challenging year in the Willamette Valley to make wine. High temperatures and drought lead to wildfires just at harvest was about to start. Not wanting to leave our growers with fruit they couldn't sell, we learned everything we could to minimize the fires impact and produce a delicious wine with a sense of place and time. Every year is a new challenge and 2020 is one we won't soon forget.

Colors – Classic Pinot garnet.

Aroma – Cranberry, fennel, cedar, jasmine.

Palate - Bright acid, cherry, earl grey tea.

Structure – Soft but present tannins with an electric finish.
