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## 2018 COONAWARRA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

### Colour

Intense crimson red.

### Aroma

Lifted oak notes of toasted spices and tobacco leaf meld seamlessly with blood plums and fire-roasted pimentos.

### Palate

Beautifully textured tannins with lovely fine length, and an abundance of dark fruits with spice.

### Food matching

A perfectly cook marbled Scotch Fillet steak, or a wonderfully simple dish of grilled pine mushrooms with herbs on some crusty bread.

### Cellaring

This wine is offering great vibrancy and freshness now, but will also develop beautifully with age for the next 10 years and beyond.

### Wine Summary

Cabernet Sauvignon is Coonawarra's pre-eminent grape variety. Parcels of premium fruit are selected, fermented and then aged in French oak barrels to produce this full bodied and richly flavoured wine.
