



SEYVAL BLANC 2019

Georgian Hills Vineyards mission is to produce distinct quality wines, showcasing all that Georgian Bay and Ontario has to offer.

This emerging wine region has a unique microclimate! Cooler than the Niagara Peninsula being a more northerly latitude (45th parallel), a higher altitude +300ft above Lake Ontario with a cooler lake effect from the colder body of water of Georgian Bay.

Seyval Blanc is a cold climate early ripening varietal that grows well in the Georgian Bay region and delivers a unique flavour profile and style quite different than when grown in warmer wine regions.

VARIETAL:

94% Seyval Blanc 6% Riesling

VINEYARD:

Seyval Blanc - Georgian Hills Vineyards, Beaver Valley.

Riesling - Wismer Vineyards Twenty Mile Bench, Niagara

BOUQUET:

Fresh green apple, pear, lime zest

PALATE:

A full flavoured white wine with a medley of pear, green apple, stone fruit and a lively lift of citrus.

11.9% alc./vol
