



The Young family have owned their 448-acre ranch in Alexander Valley for over 160 years, with 6 generations actively living on and farming the land.

Robert Young Vineyards is the largest family-owned grower of premium grapes in Alexander Valley, and Robert Young was the first to plant Cabernet Sauvignon in the valley back in 1963. The family has grown grapes for many leading premium wineries; including Chateaux St. Jean, Ferrari Carano, Pride, Simi, Rodney Strong, among others. In fact, the Chateaux St. Jean Robert Young Vineyards Chardonnay was the first vineyard designated wine in the US in 1973.

The family started Robert Young Estate Winery in 1997, selecting only 5% of the grapes they grow from the best vineyard blocks on their property for their estate wines. The Robert Young Estate wines are sold almost entirely direct to our members, with some limited placements at local restaurants. In November 2018, we opened the new Scion House Hospitality center for seated, private tastings with a spectacular view of the Alexander Valley and surrounding vineyards.
