



Château Lanbersac is the first vineyard acquisition of the Lannoye family. It is a property of 22 hectares located south of the calcareous table land of the Puisseguin Saint-Emilion appellation. An important restructuring work has been undertaken allowing a better match between the plant and its terroir.

Vineyard Age: 35 years old

Terroir: clay and limestone, clay and siliceous and silty limestone

Ageing: 80% in vats, 20% in wood

Blend: 90% Merlot - 10% Cabernet Franc

Tasting notes: Nice garnet color with Bigarreau sherry tints. The nose is greedy with aromas of Napoleon sherry and toffee notes. In the mouth, the nice acidity is enhanced by a pleasant oakyness, mellow and matured tannins with red fruits notes in the final.

Food pairing: Beef ribs, bison steak, sauté of pork, strong cheeses
