### MY BIO BY WINEMAKER JORDAN FIORENTINI

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The 2015 Ingenuity presents all its characteristic black and blue fruits, spice and licorice, however, it does so in a more reserved fashion than most vintages. This California Rhône blend continues to reveal fresh aromatics after being open for 24-plus-hours, and the tannins move from picante to velvety as oxygen softens their structure. Enjoy the bramble berry, roasted herbs, smoked meats, graphite, wet rock and sweet tobacco notes that ride high on the palate, continuously evolving.
